WHO?

 "People4Soil" is a coalition of 350 European NGOs, research institutes, farmers associations and environmental groups in all EU member states.

 They are very worried about the increasing degradation of soils both in the EU and at global level

WHY?

- At the moment, soil is not subject to a coherent set of rules in the Union: the proposal for a Soil Framework Directive has been withdrawn in May 2014 after it ran into a blocking minority for eight years.
- Existing EU policies in other areas such as agriculture, water, waste, chemicals, and prevention of industrial pollution are not sufficient to ensure an adequate level of protection for all soils in Europe.



WHAT?


- We want to push European institutions to adopt binding legal instruments to ensure a high level protection of soils in Europe, fixing principles and rules to be complied by the Member States.
- We want Europe to recognize soil as a shared heritage essential for our lives and to assume its sustainable management as a primary commitment.



HOW?

- European citizens have the right to recommend EU legislation via the European Citizens' Initiative (ECI).
- A citizens' initiative has to be backed by at least one million EU citizens within a year time frame!
- 350 organistions are already at the start of the campaign promoters of a European petition targeted at introducing a specific legislation on soil in Europe.


